#### SEMINAR'S CONCEPT

This seminar seeks to provide a space for reflection and comparison of variegated trajectories of transdisciplinarity in Southeast Asian Studies. Since transdisciplinary inquiry not only requires innovative research methods, but also challenges researchers (many of whom work isolated in the so-called "ivory towers") as well as professional experts (many of whom are disconnected from civil society), the basic questions that will open the event are: What are the purposes of transdisciplinary contributions? Who should participate? What methods can be used? During the seminar, moreover, the following four issues will both figure prominently and be employed as entry points for the seminar's exploration on transdisciplinary inquiry in Southeast Asian Studies:

- Discourses of Transdisciplinarity
- · Hidden Agendas, Positionality, and "Stakeholders"
- Collaborative Processes & Knowledge Production
- Methods of Synthesis: Implementation
